UTAH BEEF COUNCIL REIMBURSEMENT GUIDELINES AND FORM

In response to the lack of accurate information many students have about beef, the Utah Beef Council has compiled a Beef Unit and Lab Plan. This unit is unique in that it is designed so each group of students will perform different activities and then share what they have learned with the rest of the class. This method of design increases the flexibility of the lab plan for different classroom needs, it increases the amount of learning that can occur in one class period and also reduces the amount of money that will need to be spent on any one cut of beef.

We recognize that the most expensive part of conducting these labs would be the purchasing of beef. To help mitigate this cost, the beef council is willing to reimburse teachers up to \$60/year for the purchase of beef when using the lab plan. We know that funds are limited and that many teachers pay for supplies out of their own pockets.

Complete the following steps to receive your reimbursement:

- Complete the attached reimbursement form.
- Include grocery store sales receipt (original or CLEAR copy) with the name of the store, date of purchase, and price of meat circled.

- *Reimbursement application must be sent within TWO MONTHS of the date that appears on the grocery store receipt.*
